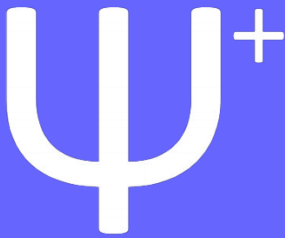
2. Description
