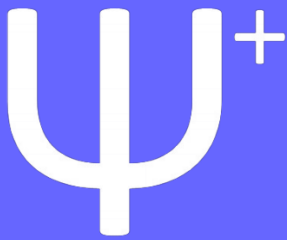

All contributions must be submitted by 31 January 2018.

At the end of the submission deadline, the evaluation of the contributions begins, in which each contribution is evaluated independently and anonymously by two reviewers. Symposia receive a joint overall assessment. On the basis of the initial assessment, the conference chairs decide on the final evaluation of the contributions. You will receive an e-mail after completion of the evaluation process, which will inform you whether your contribution has been accepted.
